



NEW PROCEDURE FOR UNSUPERVISED PATRONS AGES 13-17

In order to ensure a positive experience for all patrons, guests ages 13-17 visiting Sholem Aquatic Center without a guardian present must provide a State or Champaign Park District issued photo ID. This procedure includes older siblings, etc. who are supervising younger children and also pool pass holders who are ages 13-17 attending without a guardian. Entry for anyone ages 13-17 without a guardian will not be permitted without the approved ID.

Additional Notes:

- Children with parents/guardians present will not be affected.
- Day Camps with members between ages 13-17 will not be affected.
- Anyone with a guardian (age 18+) present will not be affected.
- Anyone ages 12 and under, or 18+, will not be affected.

Why?

This new procedure will help us to have reliable emergency contact information in the case of an incident. If a guest needs emergency assistance or help getting home, we will better know who to reach out to.

What if my teen doesn't have an ID?

Entry for anyone ages 13-17 without a guardian will not be permitted without the approved forms of ID. The Champaign Secretary of State Facility is within walking distance (2012 Round Barn Rd.) of Sholem Aquatic Center and a State ID may be obtained at a reasonable rate. Patrons that cannot utilize this option may have a parent/guardian fill out a form and obtain a Champaign Park District issued ID.

What will be done with IDs?

With each entry, the guest's ID will be collected by the ticket office and placed in a secure location until the patron leaves the facility. At that time, the ID will be returned upon request. No information will be stored unless deemed crucial by Sholem Aquatic Center management, typically in the case of an incident.
