# CHAMPAIGN PARK DISTRICT

## PURPOSE

The Champaign Park District was organized in 1911 and established as a separate unit of local government in 1955 by a referendum.

The mission of the Park District is to enhance our community's quality of life through positive experiences in parks, recreation, and cultural arts.

## PROFILE

### Population

The Park District's population per the 2010 census is 81,055 and currently estimated as of July 2016 at 86,637. The Park District also serves the University of Illinois population and the City of Urbana through a reciprocal agreement with the Urbana Park District.

### Assessed Valuation

The equalized assessed valuation for real estate for 2017 is \$1,774,495,522.

### Tax Rate

The property tax rate for 2017 is 0.7149 per \$100 of assessed value.

### Current Budget

The operating budget for FYE2019 is \$19,071,067. The fiscal year begins May 1 and ends April 30.

### Staff

The Park District has an appointed Executive Director responsible for the administration of the Park District. The Park District employs 72 full-time staff, 9 full-time 2 regular staff, and approximately 700 part-time, seasonal, and temporary workers.

## BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS & ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF

The Park District is governed by five elected residents of Champaign who voluntarily give their services to the Community. The Commissioners elect a President and Vice President and appoint a Treasurer, Board Secretary, and Assistant Secretary.

The Park Board holds its regular meetings on the second Wednesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at the Bresnan Meeting Center, 706 Kenwood Road. Residents are invited to attend and are welcome to make suggestions or comments to improve the programs or facilities offered.
